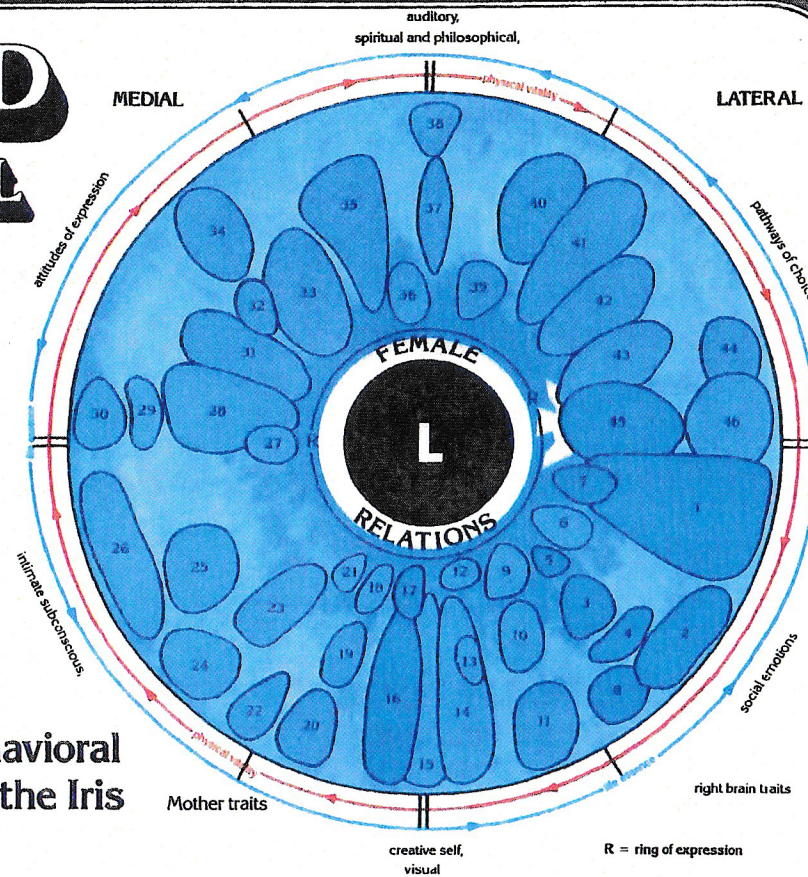
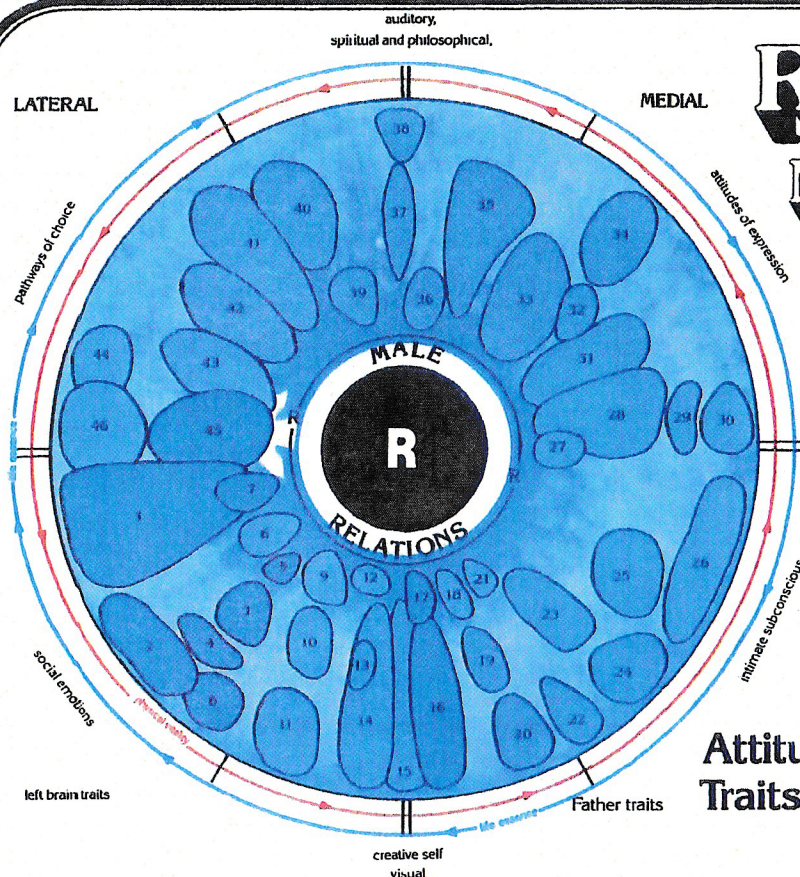


# RAYID MODEL



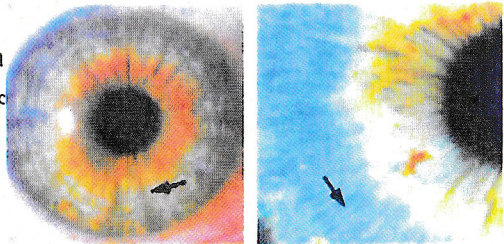
## A Guide to Attitudes and Behavioral Traits as Found in the Iris

Within the human iris is a pattern revealing how we think, act, and choose relationships. Each physical variation in the eye is a reflection of the *mental and spiritual* qualities within the individual. These compelling patterns are inherited from our ancestors. They are altered during a life time of relationships and transferred genetically to future generations. Discover for yourself the joy of truly knowing others.

Use this chart to compare the different areas of the iris. Each area has a specific emotion, ability, or behavioral trait associated with it. Evaluate these according to the attitude ranges found on the reverse side of this chart. There are three classical types from which all patterns originate. These are symbolically called "Streams, Flowers, and Jewels." Each is a different mode of communication and learning.

### Stream

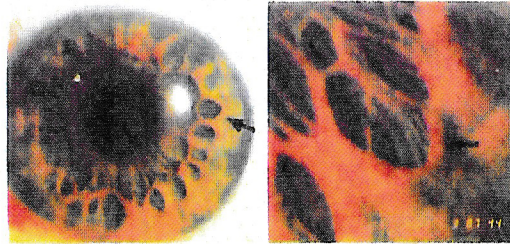
Kinesthetic



**Streams** are subtle variations in the iris fibers that appear as straight lines or streaks of colors. Stream personalities are *physically sensitive*, and energetically respond to others with delicate gestures. They choose words such as "That's touching..." that strikes me..." and "Huuuuuu." They are intuitive and subconsciously learn best through *experience and touch*. They are attracted to personalities with a jewel-flower combination.

### Flower

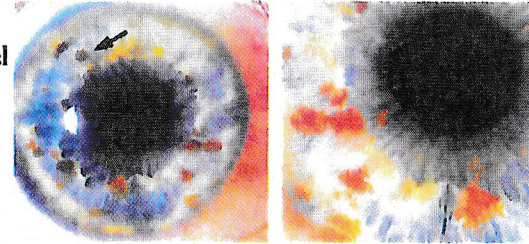
Emotional



**Flowers** are rounded openings in the fibers of the iris. Flower-type personalities are *emotional*, and spontaneous. They respond to life with feelings and visual communication. They often use descriptions like "I see...", "imagine this..." and "Oooooo." These visual people use many gestures and subconsciously learn most when given *auditory* instructions. They are attracted to jewel-type personalities for long term relationships.

### Jewel

Mental



**Jewels** are dot-like concentrations that range in color from light gold to black. Jewel personalities usually respond to others with analysis, thinking, and *sounds*. They mostly use words such as "I think...", "I hear..." and "Aaaaaah." These intellectual people use few physical gestures and subconsciously learn best from *visual* instruction. They are attracted to emotional, flower-type individuals for long term relationships.
